*Christian G. Riedig*

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
In 1831 the heirs of Johann George Schreiber of Leipzig published the first edition of a pocket atlas of the world in oblong format 95 x 125 mm. Its title-page was printed on the front of the soft cover and included a contents list. The twenty-one lithographic maps measure 90/104 x 73/82 mm. and were drawn by M. (that is Christian Gottlieb) Riedig (1768-1853) and are usually found with outline hand-colour:

*Oestliche Halbkugel; Westliche Halbkugel; Europa; Spanien und Portugal; Frankreich; Brittanien; Holland und Belgien; Nord Deutschland; Das Königreich Sachsen; Baiern, Würtemberg und Baden; Die Schweiz; Italien; Die Oestrreichische Monarchie; Daenemark; Schweden und Norwegen; Europäisches Russland; Die Europäische Turkey; Asia; Africa; America; Australien.*



The second edition which appeared in 1833 had three extra maps: *Das Planeten system; Weltkarte; Polen, Lithauen, Curland Volhynien, Podolien*. The uncoloured solar system chart has the imprint: 'Leipzig bei Schreibers Erben'.

Reprints included one published in Berlin in 1838 but oddly, although it contained the extra maps, they were not mentioned on the new title-page. A further edition was issued in 1849 with a slightly different title, together with a pocket celestial atlas in the same format (see 1849a).
